7. Mynwent Capel Cana

Llythyr wedi dod i law gan Gyfundeb Eglwysi'r Annibynwyr ar Ynys Môn. Wedi ei gylchredeg. Cais i'r Cyngor gymryd cyfrifoldeb am Fynwent Capel Cana. Dweud y byddai cyfraniad ariannol ond ddim yn dweud faint fyddai o. Costau cynnal a chadw, ond byddai modd ei wneud fel rhan o'r gwaith yn y Fynwent Newydd. Ddim yn effeithio ar yr yswiriant. 1. Welcome and Apologies

2. Matters Arising

Minutes accepted by Joanna Robertson, seconded by Margaret Clarke.

Wildlife trust had a stall in the school fair, are going to recruit members of the community, and have an open forum etc.

Llanddaniel green: bin frame removed, Openreach box put underground.

• Precept 2023

Finance Committee met on Monday 9 January, and set the budget for the year. Suggestion to raise the Precept from last year's figure, £11,300, to a higher figure of £11,865 for 2023. A raise of 5% which is not considerable, but living costs are rising. Need to consider the money in the bank and use it on projects. APPROVED – all agreed.

6. Letters to Discuss

A letter from Annibynwyr Môn – on the agenda.

7. Capel Cana Cemetery

A letter from Union of Independent Chapels on Anglesey. Circulated. A request that the Council takes responsibility for the Capel Cana Cemetery. Financial contribution but no details on how much. There would be maintenance costs, but this could be done as part of the work at the New Cemetery. Won't affect the insurance. The sum is important – won't pay for ever. Are there implications, eg. access. Can the area be maintained more sensitively? Who is responsible for the boundaries? The wall – that would be us, and covered by insurance. Current owner doing good work. It would be responsible to make an assessment – ask the contractors.

In the past, a similar request from the Church: need to be clear that this is Cana only. But a different situation.

ALL AGREED with the intention.

8. Community Broadband

This would be a benefit in yr Efail, for the meetings apart from anything else. Came up as a result of the finance meeting. What would the cost be – less than £50 a month? Grants available. It would make for opportunities. Everybody in support, next step is pricing.

9. Footpaths

Problem with the stile on one of the paths. Someone had a fall. Slippery and no handrail. Ask Arwel what the plans are for the stile, is there a way of bypassing it? Following up because there has been an accident. Path past Tyddyn Eurach and behind Plas Hen very wet indeed.

Community walk idea – everybody saw this as a good idea. Joanna to arrange.

10. Playground – Update

Igloo has been sorted by D. Hughes, free of charge. Very grateful to him. Liz has contacted the two companies. G L Jones – large sum for moving the Menai unit and putting down new mats: between 4500-7500. Ace have responded, also not willing to move the unit.

Can a smaller, local company be used?

Would it be a cheaper option to open a ditch and drain the area? Then new mats. People's opinions on moving the equipment or draining. Drain first. Margaret to ask about this.

Also, the fence is being bent down. Options. Currently a chain link fence, but a more solid fence is an option. The fence around the footpath is a success.

Linked: dog mess. Need to ask the school again about CCTV. Signage can be very effective too. Worth leafletting the village? Need to catch and report people.

Also leaves on the paths. A group to tidy up? Would show a presence.

11. Road Safety – Update

List of priorities sent to the Council, and had a response. Doesn't say much. Street light: in a very dark spot. ALL AGREED to go ahead with this. No pavement there so justification for the light.

Need another meeting to discuss the response to this. Inconsistencies in terms of regions. Not a satisfactory response. Meeting to be organised.

The road from the village to Ffingar closed because of a branch. Another likely to fall.

12. Reports of any meetings

No meetings have been held.

13. County Councillors' Report

A quiet time at the Council. Costs discussed: in order to maintain the same level of service as last year, council tax needs to rise by 12%, but going to keep it lower with an increase of around 5%.

Free Port under discussion again. Has been a matter of some debate but it is likely that it would be a good thing for Anglesey. Stena in support, and opportunities for green jobs. In Wales Holyhead is the obvious place for this.
