9. Gwasanaeth Post

Gwasanaeth Post yn dod i ben ddiwedd y mis. Nid oes modd darparu gwasanaeth post symudol. Pobl leol wedi cwyno; yr eglurhad yw nad oes digon o alw, ac maent hefyd wedi cael problemau technegol. Dafydd yn holi oes modd gwneud trefniadau eraill, ond ddim yn edrych yn addawol. Posibilrwydd o drefnu bws neu lifft yn lleol? Roedd hyn yn broblem pan oedd y ffordd wedi cau. Trafnidiaeth cymunedol yn beth da, ond angen ystyried yn ddwys. Ymateb trwy lythyr.

10. Band Eang Cymunedol

Alon yn cytuno a byddwn yn cael defnyddio Yr Efail am ddim. Dim angen llinell ffôn: ffeibr fyddai'r dewis gorau. Byddai modd cael pris gan Openreach, ond byddai'n ddrud. Medrwn Môn: wedi ymateb yn gyflym, gallu trefnu wifi am ddim am chwe mis ac ystyried opsiynau parhaol. Pwy fyddai'n monitro? Os problem gyda'r cyfrinair, byddai modd ei newid. Risg yn isel o ran diogelwch, a byddai'n hawdd gweld petai'r system yn cael ei chamddefnyddio (e.e. defnyddio'r lwfans i gyd mewn mis). PAWB YN CYTUNO i ymateb a derbyn yr opsiwn am ddim.

11. Cae Chwarae – Diweddariad

Pris am y gwaith draenio o gwmpas yr offer: £2,769.00. Gwaith i gynnwys cloddio, gosod cerrig mân. Ymateb da ar gyfer draenio ond ddim yn addas ar gyfer yr offer chwarae. Y pris yn uchel ac angen cwmni arbenigol i ail-osod yr offer.

Ond, hefyd, gwaith draenio arall yn y cae chwarae – ar y ffin, ond mynd trwy'r cae chwarae. Yr unig wybodaeth wedi dod gan y gweithwyr, nid yn swyddogol. Sôn am hyn wedi bod flwyddyn yn ôl: cymhleth, sawl adran yn y Cyngor yn rhan o hyn. Ansicr beth yw'r gwaith a neb wedi cysylltu â'r Cyngor Cymuned.

Y cae chwarae yn wlyb ond gallai'r gwaith hwn sortio'r broblem. Dal yn ôl efo'r broblem draenio tan y byddwn yn gwybod mwy.

Cysylltu efo Sarah o'r Cyngor i ni gael gwybod beth yw'r cynlluniau, a chael gweld y cynlluniau. Hefyd holi ynghylch y ffiniau. Dafydd i gysylltu hefyd. PAWB YN CYTUNO. (Wedyn holi oes modd helpu'r cae chwarae.)

7. Capel Cana Cemetery

Telephone conversation; the sum they are offering to pay is £10k. Need confirmation of this sum in writing. The money will need to be ringfenced.

The contractor's price for additional work: £504.80 y flwyddyn. ALL AGREED to take on the cemetery at Capel Cana.

8. Maintenance Contracts

Two prices – Holyhead Town Council are the current contractors.

It would be good to support a local person but the price difference is too substantial. ALL AGREED to award the contract to Holyhead Town Council.

9. Postal Service

The postal service in the village will end at the end of the month. They cannot provide a mobile service. Local people have complained; the justification is that there is not enough demand, and they have also had technical problems. Dafydd has asked about alternative arrangements but it is not looking good. Possibility of organising a bus or lift shares locally? This was also an issue when the road was closed. Community transport is good[^] thing but it needs to be considered in detail. Respond by letter. _{SCB}

10. Community Broadband

Alon in agreement and we would not pay to use Yr Efail. No need to put a phone line in: fibre would be the best option. Could get a price from Openreach but likely to be expensive. Medrwn Môn responded quickly and can arrange free wifi for six months, and also look into something more permanent. Who would monitor this? If password problems, could be changed. Also low risk in terms of security, and it would be easy to tell if the system was being abused (e.g. using all the allowance in a month). ALL AGREED to respond and go ahead with the free option.

11. Playground - Update

Price for the draining work around the equipment: £2,769.00. Work would include excavation, putting down gravel and stones. A good option for drainage but not appropriate for play equipment. The price is high and a specialist company would be needed to put the equipment back.

But also, other drainage work in the playground – on the boundaries, but accessing through the playground. No real information, only hearsay from the workers. Talk of this a year ago: complex, several Council departments involved. Uncertain what the work is and nobody has contacted the Community Council.

The playground is wet, but this work could sort the problem. Hold off on the drainage work until we know more.

Contact Sarah at the Council to ask what the plans are, and whether we can see these plans. Also ask about the boundaries. Dafydd to contact too. ALL AGREED. (Then ask if it can be adjusted to help the playground.)

12. Road Safety - Update

Joanna's response to the letter from the Council: expressing disappointment. Margaret has examined the Highway Code, and the Highways Act. Need to respond, because they have made points but not responded properly to the comments. Suggest that they reconsider: they acknowledge that they need to do things. No road markings: need maintenance. Going to send in a written response. Everybody to look at this again, and respond to Margaret; Clerk will send in a formal written response. Add comment from the public: the road from Pink lodge to Plas Newydd should have continuous white lines.

13. Defib Training

Used in an emergency again, and a member of the public asked about this, how to use it, where to get information. A second person now responsible for the Defib (a member of Trigolion), and an email from Save a Life Wales: they can't easily organise training. Look into organising this locally.

14. Reports of Any Meetings

No meetings.

15. County Councillor's Report

The big subject is closing the Two Sisters plant in Llangefni, helping with the task force. They went straight to the 45 day consultation period. State that hte site is too small – employing 730 people but competing with huge sites. Very small in comparison to their competitors and focusing on more competitive sites. Suggested moving some staff to the Deeside plant. The hope is that there will be an announcement in the spring on the Free Port, and this could create jobs. But great uncertainty. This loss will strengthen the bid for the Free Port. But very little hope in the short term.
