2. Matters Arising

Minutes accepted by Dawn, seconded by Rob.

The street lamp has been installed. A new pole had to be put up.

Tyddyn Eurach path. Arwel has had a look at the footpath and has noted that it is narrow, but that the fence is near the end of its life so will ask the landowner whether the footpath could be widened while putting in a new fence.

3. Declarations of Interest

4. Planning

FPL/2023/155 Pont Ronwy. Considerable objection because there are so many holiday homes and lets around in this area. No opportunity for young men who would like to farm. A valid reason to object? An element of the Local Development Plan – losing a smallholding. Over-development. Old buildings are more expensive to maintain so young people are less keen to buy them – affordable housing is being built to fill the gap. Waiting lists for houses.

LBC/2023/17 Capel Cana. Listed building consent – putting in a flue, and it will be more appropriate. No objection.

6. Letters to Discuss

An email from Ysgol Parc y Bont, asking for a contribution towards the school festival. This has been, email came in between meetings. It would be good to give a donation – several of the older people in the community love going. Agree on £100.

7. Risk Assessment

Thanks to Rob for doing the excellent risk assessment. Did we need to include financial risks? Different documents for these. Risk assessment ACCEPTED. Some things to add. Need a new seat for the bench in the playground, and the new fence, a piece has broken (with children climbing). Huw is in the playground anyway. The trees in the Cemetery need cutting back. This is something to do in the next year. Consider this and see what the situation is. The fence around the war memorial – corroded. The wall needs re-pointing. Dafydd to contact: there may be a charity which does this work.

8. Dog poo bins

The bag dispenser has been moved to a new area. Asked about getting more bins, and told that there are none available. A map showing the locations of existing bins received, but not very clear. Not many bins in the village but none can be had either and we would need to make an arrangement with a private contractor for them.

Bags for the dispensers. Liz has been in touch. Guto to refill them.

9. Playground Update

Huw's price accepted, and the work starts next week. Contacted the Council to discuss the cost, and chased them about this too.

Children still playing in the trees. Should there be a sign to say that it's dangerous? Children have been going there for decades – has there been a serious accident? Wait for Huw to do the work then see how things are.

10. Capel Cana Update

A solicitor has been appointed, from R. Gordon Roberts Laurie & Co. Waiting to hear.

11. Report of any meetings

Governors. Everything seems to be fine in the school, things running well. Numbers have gone back to how they were, following a period of lower numbers. Hoping to have an assessment of the school in case an extension is needed.

12. County Councillor's Report

Dafydd dealing with Education, Schools, and Welsh Language. The Executive Committee meets tomorrow, and a report on the bridges: there was an agreement to build a third bridge but this was changed, but Anglesey is the only part of Wales where you need to cross the sea to get here. Even the new bridge is very old. Need a solution. No hospital on the island, need to be able to cross. Many arguments in favour, but the Government is against it, and the cost is a factor.
