7. Gwasanaeth Bws

Arriva wedi datgan eu bod yn dod â'r gwasanaeth bws i ben yn y pentref. Llythyr wedi dod i law gan breswylwr lleol, a Dafydd wedi ymateb. Hefyd y Cyngor Sir wedi anfon llythyr yn egluro'r sefyllfa.

Y bysus oddi ar yr A5 yn cael eu tynnu yn ôl. Yr unig ddatblygiadau ydi bod llawer yn cwyno, ac wedi cael cyfarfod efo Arriva ddwywaith. Honni mai 5 bob diwrnod sydd yn defnyddio'r bws. Am ryddhau'r rhifau i'r Cyngor. Gwasanaeth preifat yw Arriva. Y Cyngor yn talu am rai gwasanaethau e.e. un o Frynsiencyn, a bwriadu dargyfeirio, ond y cwmni ddim yn fodlon i ddod trwy Llanddaniel oherwydd asesiad risg. Opsiynau eraill: wedi gofyn i Arriva gario ymlaen am ychydig. Defnyddio bysus colegau bore a phrynhawn:

gweithio i rai pobl. Fel arall, trafodaethau gyda phobl fel Menter Môn a chael gwasanaeth cymunedol. Gwasanaeth hanfodol yn y bôn, ond cwmni preifat ydi Arriva. Cyllideb yn dyn iawn, chwyddiant yn uchel, colledion mawr.

Flexi buses yng Nghonwy, ac hyn yn cael ei drafod hefyd.

Problemau traffig – amhosib cerdded. Angen blaenoriaethu ffordd ddiogel i gerdded at y safle bws agosaf.

Dim ateb gan yr adran Briffyrdd. Ond rhan o'r active travel. Sut mae delio â hyn? Oes modd codi hyn yn sgil colli'r gwasanaeth bws.

Angen llinellau dwbl ar y groeslon. Y ffensys plastig wrth yr arwydd Llanddaniel ger Star. Y ffordd yn beryglus a phroblemau ychwanegol.

Beth am gael y cyflymdra i 30 o Ffingar at yr arwydd 20. Dim pafin, Llwybr yr Arfordir.

8. Diweddariad Capel Cana

Wedi sawl wythnos, y papurau wedi cael eu paratoi ac yn barod i gael eu llofnodi. Y bil yn uchel – £738 – a disgwyl y trosglwyddiad gan yr Annibynwyr. Talu'r bil o'r swm sy'n dod, ynteu o'r arian Cyngor Cymuned. O'r cyfrif presennol a ring-fence i'r arian sydd i ddod.

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6. Letters to Discuss

One has come in, re: the bus service. See next item.

7. Bus Service

Arriva have stated that they are ending the bus service in the village. A letter has come in from a local resident, and Dafydd has responded. Also Ynys Môn have sent a letter explaining the situation.

The buses coming off the A5 are being stopped. The only developments are that many are complaining, and the Council have met with Arriva twice. They claim that an average of 5 per day use the bus. Will release the numbers to the Council. Arriva is a private service. The Council pays for some services, e.g. from Brynsiencyn, and intend to redirect this, but the company is not keen to come through Llanddaniel because of a risk assessment. Other options: Arriva have been asked to carry on for a bit. Using college buses morning and evening: will work for some people. Otherwise, discussions with people like Menter Môn

and community services. The service is essential, but Arriva is a private company. The budget is very tight, inflation is high, big losses.

Flexi buses in Conwy, this is also under discussion.

Traffic problems – it is impossible to walk. Need to prioritise a safe way to walk to the nearest bus stop.

No response from Highways. But part of the active travel survey. How can this be dealt with? Can it be raised again as a result of losing the bus service.

Need double yellow lines on the crossroads. The plastic fences by the Llanddaniel sign near Star: the road is dangerous and this adds extra problems.

Suggestion of having a 30 limit from Ffingar to the 20 sign. No pavement, Coastal Path.

8. Update on Capel Cana

After several weeks, the papers have been prepared and are ready to be signed. The bill is high – £738 – and waiting on the transfer from the Annibynwyr. Pay the bill from the sum which is coming, or from the Community Council's money? From the current account and ring-fence the money which is to come in.

9. Reports of Any Meetings

No meetings. But Cylch in danger of closing down: need officers. A meeting was held last week.

10. County Councillors' Report

Dafydd has the Education Portfolio so the concrete problems. Has been to YDH and spoken with the head. Some parts of the school are closed. YDH, the children are all back, and the situation is not ideal but it is workable. Holyhead is terrible. There will be a solution soon. Secondary schools have been repaired and are all reaching the end of the period around the same time.
