Path near Noddfa – new people have started to move to Tyddyn Bach but they are not there full time. They are keen to sort this as soon as possible.

Meetings are being held with the bus service. Still some hope. A questionnaire from Medrwn Môn – not the Council but feeding in to the Council. People keen to volunteer. Medrwn Môn organising volunteers and if people need help then they can contact Medrwn Môn to make arrangements.

6. Letters to Discuss

Environmental Health, Ynys Môn: Rat problem in Coed y Gof. Margaret has responded over email. The sense that someone has complained – and the Community Council is supportive. This has been raised in the past, and it is a real worry for the nearby residents. Individuals and contractors have left rubbish. It is worth asking the Council to clear the materials which have been left. Had a meeting in 2018, and again in 2020. This has been under discussion for 5 years. It is not our land. If it were possible to clear the left side of the path that would help. Clerk to respond – explain that we do not own the land but the matter has been discussed several times. Ask them to clear the path completely, up to the houses and 2 metres on the other side.

7. Playground and Coed y Gof Update

No update so far. Overgrowth coming into the playground and it needs to be cleared well. The contractors are not under contract at the moment. Volunteers to do this. Suggestion in the past to get tables and chairs for the playground. This would be good for the summer. There is space for 2 tables. Grant money still left over. AGREE to get tables.
