1. Welcome and Apologies

2. Matters Arising

Minutes accepted by Joanna Robertson, seconded by Rob Sargent.

Defib training: contacted Will Lovelock: he is willing to do the community session for free. Date: Clerk cannot do the set date for the next meeting of the Community Council; meeting rearranged for 22 May.

Defibrillator training on the previous Monday night: 15 Mai, 7.00-8.00.

Capel Cana cemetery – have contacted to discuss this but need legal advice? No deeds etc. Ask the Land Registry.

Ask the contractors to cut the hedge by the small gate by the houses in the New Cemetery. Also discuss cutting more sensitively in the old cemetery: but some graves have regular visitors.

Path Number 2 – no response from Tyddyn Uchaf. Send a recorded letter.

No response from Ynys Môn about the Road Safety matters.

7. Standards' Committee Newsletter

Circulated. Felt that the newsletter is very useful, summarises everything going on very well.

8. Playground, Update

Fence has been repaired. A meeting with Sion Williams, Flood Department. Discussed the flooding and the large ditch, which has an outflow in it. Sion to look into this. Much of this

is the responsibility of the Education department. Going to arrange to clear the outflow. Also looked at Coed y Gof, and the ditch there and looked from the other side. Concerns about the wet area: he couldn't understand what had been done here and why it was done in this way, and is going to contact the Education department and other departments to find out. Agreed that the rubbish needs clearing too.

Positive if it is blocked drains. No idea where Tre'r Gof's drains are – this is a concern. Would it be good to invite the local landowner to a meeting to discuss this? ALL AGREED. It is likely that anybody can see plans etc. Give Sion more time.

9. Coed y Gof, Update

Megan from the WT has offered to come to one of the meetings to give an update on the situation and possible work.

But need to answer the problem of ownership first – we don't own the land. Need to be careful about raising hopes. But Megan to explain what is possible. E.g. a stand at Gŵyl Mabsant. This fits in with the Biodiversity Plans. We don't own the land, but need to be careful that any work done isn't destroyed by work in the future by others dealing with drainage e.g.

Raise awareness of what is there, the resource, discourage people from littering. Educate people, show that this is not an abandoned area that nobody cares about. Show its biodiversity purpose. ALL AGREED for Megan Parkinson to come to the meeting.

10. Biodiversity and Resilience of Ecosystems Report

The plan has been circulated. Any comments or changes. This to be sent to the correct department as a PDF. Don't have the population numbers, or the size of the area: Rob to get the figures for the size, Dafydd to get the numbers from the census. Then send.

11. Report of Any Meetings

Governors have met to appoint Rhys Ynyr Jones as the permanent head. Received 11 applications for school places for next year which is very positive. Concern previously that the numbers were decreasing but this has changed.

12. County Councillors' Report

A fairly quiet month with Easter. Holyhead Freeport has been declared, and this is a very positive thing. Some concerns to start with but now feel that this is a very good thing. Fair wages etc.
